- 1. Photos (ex: selfies) or diagrams of biopsied site(s) are recommended for biopsy confirmation.
- 2. Continue all prescription medications including blood-thinners
- 3. Eat a normal breakfast
- 4. Bring a snack and reading material
- 5. Bring a sweater or jacket
- 6. <u>DO NOT SCHEDULE</u> any other commitments on the day of surgery.
- 7. Having a driver is a good choice, but optional
- 8. Anticipate waiting for specimen processing (1-3 hours) for each Mohs stage. Once all margins are cleared, allow

additional time for reconstruction or repair as needed.

9. All surgery is performed under local anesthesia

BUILDING REQUIREMENTS:

Wearing a mask is *optional in our office* but please keep in mind that Queen's Medical Center and ALL physician's office buildings (POB) require a mask at all times.
